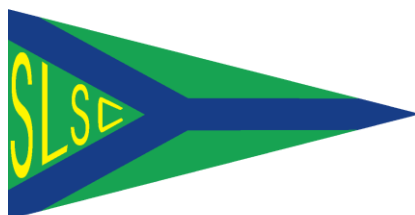

- Camping at nearby cottages in the Village of Sturgeon Point.
 - Limited billeting for Masters sailors and guests - first come/first served basis.
 - No camping on Club grounds.

- Rules:**
- Current RRS (2017-2020) with Sail Canada prescriptions, the individual class rules, and the Sailing Instructions (which will govern in the event of a conflict.)
- Classes:**
- Laser
 - Radial
 - Club 420
 - RS Feva
- Eligibility:**
- Laser and Radial sailors must be current members of the Laser Class to qualify for the Gold Cup series.
 - For the Masters category, sailors must be 35 or over as of July 28, 2018.
 - For Provincial Championships in the Laser Class, sailors must be 18

or under as of 2400 Hours on December 31, 2018.

- For Provincial Championships in the Radial Class, sailors must be 18 or under or 16 or under as of 2400 Hours on December 31, 2018.
- For Provincial Championships in the Club 420 Class, both sailors (skipper and crew) must be 18 or under or 16 or under as of 2400 Hours on December 31, 2018.
- For Provincial Championships in the RS Feva Class, both sailors (skipper and crew) must be 16 or under as of 2400 Hours on December 31, 2018.

Registration/Sailing Instructions:

- Pre-register and pay online at www.slsc.ca/Mids
- Participants, coaches and spectators to register by **July 15, 2016** to avoid late fee
- Pick up registration packages at the club on:
 - Fri July 27, 4:00pm – 9:00pm
 - Sat July 28, 8:00am – 10:00am
 - Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration.

Fees:

- Sailors: \$100 (CDN) - Includes: Sat. breakfast, lunch & dinner, Sun. breakfast and late lunch, and T-shirt; Fee is for each sailor in a double handed boat.
- Coaches: \$60(CDN) for Sat. breakfast, lunch & dinner and Sun. breakfast and late lunch, and a t-shirt
- Spectators: \$50 (CDN) for Sat. breakfast, lunch & dinner and Sun. breakfast and late lunch.
- A late fee of \$20 will be charged for registrations received after July 20

Schedule:

- Saturday July 28:
 - Competitors' Meeting 10:00am
 - First Race 11:00am
- Sunday July 29:
 - First Race 10:00am
 - No warning signal after 3:00pm

Series Format:

- A maximum of 7 races are scheduled.
- 1 or more races constitute a series.
- 1 drop with 5 or more races.

- Scoring:**
- Low Point Scoring System
 - Each of the classes will be scored as one division with the order of finish for each Provincial age group championship determined based on the order of finish of qualifying competitors in the overall division results.

- Prizes:**
- Mid Ontario Laser, Radial and Double Handed perpetual trophies for winners
 - Mid Ontario Medals
 - Top three finishers in each class
 - First Master in Laser and Radial
 - OS Provincial Championships:
 - OS Overall Club Trophy (perpetual): Awarded to the club with the most sailors competing
 - OS Singlehanded Club Trophy (perpetual): 1st place sailor and the 1st place sailor's affiliated club in each single handed class
 - OS Double Handed Club Trophy (perpetual): 1st place sailors and their affiliated club in each double handed class
 - OS Provincial 18&U and 16&U Championships:
 - Top three 18 and under Laser
 - Top three 18 and under Radial
 - Top three 16 and under Radial
 - Top three 18 and under Club 420
 - Top three 16 and under Club 420
 - Top three 16 and under RS Feva
