## **Programs 2007**

We will be operating mornings and afternoons, Monday through Friday, starting July 2<sup>nd</sup> and ending Aug 24<sup>th</sup>. Our traditional learn-to-sail-and-race programs will run each morning. Introductory programs for local community groups will run in the afternoons.

## Staffing

We are pleased to report that **Adam Arscott** will be returning as our Head Instructor this summer. Adam is well known and loved and we look forward to another summer under Adam's leadership. Adam will be responsible for overseeing the morning Learn to Sail program and the afternoon outreach program. **Murray McCullough** will be returning to SLSC as Race Coach and he will be responsible for overseeing the race program. We are delighted to have Murray's expertise and experience and he will continue to enhance our racing program. **Mike Petrosoniak**, **Sam Benson** and **Peter Nyhuus** will also be returning for the coming season. We are pleased to welcome a recent graduate and newly certified Green instructor, **Elizabeth Barr**. We are very excited about this slate of instructors and look forward to a fantastic summer.

We offer a home-cooked dinner two or three times a week for the instructors. If your family is interested in having a few of the team over for dinner, please speak to me at registration or send me an e-mail.

## Highlights

#### \* The Race Team

We have an experienced race team, coached by Murray McCullough, who will be very active this summer training and attending regattas. We will be communicating with parents of these sailors to coordinate our efforts in getting as many sailors and boats to as many regattas as possible. We will make every effort to limit the disruption to the morning program when the race team is traveling to regattas.

#### **❖** Damage Policy

A few summers ago, we instituted a damage policy to encourage sailors to take more care and responsibility for the boats and to provide some form of recourse for the Sailing Club should we experience significant damage or lost equipment. The damage policy is as follows and applies to students in White Sail II and above.

All sailors will be instructed on proper rigging techniques. Prior to launching the boat they are sailing, and recognizing that students do not necessarily sail the boat they rigged, the students are responsible for checking that the boats they are to sail are rigged properly.

The cost of replacing or repairing lost or damaged equipment will be shared 50/50 between SLSC and the students, collectively, in the boats concerned.

- ❖ Wednesday Afternoon Races will continue again this summer. We hope that all juniors registered in the morning programs will participate whether they are at club for a week or a month! The Afternoon Races begin on July 11th and run over four Wednesdays: July 11<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> and August 8<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>. The races run from 1:30 pm − 3:30pm.
- ❖ Wednesday Pizza Lunches at the club are back by popular demand! These lunches are hosted by the Directors and are for all junior sailors registered in the morning programs. Pizza lunch will start on July 11<sup>th</sup>. Please note that pick up time will be 1 pm on this day and all Wednesdays where there are no afternoon races or if your child chooses not to race. The price for a large slice of pizza, a drink and a treat will be \$7.50. Orders will be taken and money will be collected on Monday and Tuesday mornings each week as the juniors arrive.

#### Registration

Enclosed you will find a registration package for the coming summer. As in past years, we strongly recommend pre-registration to ensure a spot in the program(s) of your choice. Priority will be given to families who pre-register. The purchase of a sailing manual is recommended for all White and Bronze sailors and these manuals can be purchased on Monday mornings. Please note that a whistle attached to each sailor's lifejacket is recommended. There will be whistles available for purchase at registration. In an effort to move to electronic communication, which reduces the cost of photocopying and postage, we have included a request for your e-mail address on the application form. A reminder to all sailors to bring the following on the first day at club: lifejacket (PFD), water shoes, bathing suit and towel, hat, change of clothes, sunscreen, water and a snack.

#### Fees 2007

- ❖ **Program Fees** will be \$160 per week per junior. We continue to try to move the club towards a financial position where operating expenses are covered by operating revenues, leaving donations and proceeds from the "Gala" to build our capital fund which in turn allows for *gradual* fleet replacement.

- ❖ Family Membership fees remain at \$100 again this year. This membership fee is for families who do not have children in the morning sailing programs. The family membership fee gives these families one vote at the Annual General Meeting and helps to defray the cost of running the Sunday Afternoon Race Series in which we encourage participation from sailors of every age. A family membership is also a requirement for those taking private lessons or renting a boat for the Civic Holiday regatta. (Note: All families with children in the morning programs have the benefits of membership without paying this fee.)
- ❖ **Private Adult Lessons** are available with any of the instructors after 4:00 pm on weekdays, or on weekends. The instructors will charge an hourly rate. For adults who do not have a child registered in the morning program, payment of the Family Membership will be requested. Please drop by the club to arrange your lesson with an instructor!

#### Racing

- ❖ Sunday Afternoon Series: July 1<sup>st</sup>, July 29<sup>th</sup>, August 12<sup>th</sup> and August 19th: These races are open to all classes of sailboat. Adults and juniors alike are welcome. The first race will start at 1:30 pm. We hope to sail three races each Sunday. A Notice of Race for this series will be available at the club and will be posted on the Sturgeon Point notice boards (outside the Village Office and by the mailboxes) by July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Civic Holiday Regatta: Saturday August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2007 Juniors and adults alike are encouraged to participate in this annual SLSC regatta! For adults who wish to borrow a club boat, there may be some available. The Family membership fee will apply to these sailors without a family member registered in the morning programs. Registration starts at 9:00 am and the skippers' meeting is at 10 am. The regatta fee will be \$5.00 per person.

The regatta BBQ will be at Rosehill at 6 pm on August 5<sup>th</sup> and everyone is welcome. Dinner is \$15/adult and \$10/child and you may pay at the door.

### **Boat Slips**

There are a number of slips available for rent. Rates are as follows:

Season (May – Oct ): \$250
Monthly: \$125
Weekend: \$25
